

PMF Past and Present Activities Report

Pre-Election Activities: (General Election-2014)

Review of facts and deprival of basic facilities in these villages are:

- No safe and clean drinking water: Many villages are starving for drinking water. Whatever the little or small amount of water available for drinking & irrigation is contaminated heavily with fluorine, pesticides and chemicals. Drinking such fluorine contaminated water has caused fluorosis to many people in these villages and constituency. According to the WHO reports, even if the fluorine free drinking water is supplied from now onwards, it will take 3 more generations to eradicate the fluorosis symptoms in this area. Such a strong and hazardous affect is created due to the consumption of fluorine affected water in this area.
- No sanitary sewage system: Entire Thungathurthy constituency, including the selected 6 six villages, need proper sanitation and sewage facilities. Open defecation is a common practice in these areas. Public and private toilets should be at least minimal levels in this constituency. Govt schools do not have toilets, and the girl child school dropout is mainly because of this. An open sewage system is a breeding place for mosquitoes and other pathogens spreading vulnerable diseases like malaria, cholera etc.
- No transportation facility: Poor transportation facility leaves these villages connected to the other villages and Mandal headquarters. During Monson season, the situation is much worse. The lack of CC roads is affecting farmers as they cannot transport their farm produce to the markets for a better price. At night, travelling to these villages is very difficult, even on 2-wheelers.
- No power: It has become a common practice for all political parties to announce free and uninterrupted power to the farmers during election campaigns. After the elections, these governments have yet to be able to provide minimum and uninterrupted power supply for irrigation and household purposes. Poor farm output and farmers suicide in this area are mainly because of the pathetic power supply. It's also observed that the majority of the electric poles in the streets are not having bulbs leaving these villages in complete darkness after sunset.
- Non availability of efficient public hospital/s: Almost 90% of the villagers are having some or other chronic health diseases like Fluorosis, TB, Cataract, Orthopaedic problems, Malnutrition, Dental problems etc. Reason for such a level of illnesses is due to the consumption of Fluorine and pesticide contaminated drinking water, poor



sewage system, consumption of country-made illicit liquor, malnourishment due to poor economy etc. A survey has also revealed that there is hardly any efficient Public Health Clinic (PHC) in this region. Wherever the PHCs are available, there are few facilities, no sufficient doctors and medicines to cure these villagers.

In some survey forms we even read some children writing and pleading to take their parents to some good hospitals for treatment as they do not have money and support to treat their parents' illness. [Extract at page:]

- **No govt school for higher education in English medium:** Education system is pathetic and neglected in these areas. Schools here don't have minimum facilities like sufficient number of teachers, class rooms, benches, toilets, drinking water etc. None of these villages have an English medium school.

Activities of Peoples Manifesto

Pre-Election

- a. Visited Mandals and villages to identify the local volunteers and coordinators who have the right social consciousness and willingness to work for the village development.
- b. Selection of survey volunteers to conduct villages' survey for developing Peoples Manifesto.
- c. Conducted Peoples Manifesto survey by using a questionnaire as a tool.
- d. Analysing, compiling and printing the survey booklets.
- e. Had personal meetings with all the contesting candidates and took their commitment in writing.

Village Survey for Developing Peoples Manifesto

To voice the actual needs and demands of people in Thungathurthi constituency, we have selected 6 villages (one village from each Mandal) for the survey and conducted a door-to-door survey with the help of local volunteers. Survey was focused to identify and voice the actual village, street, community, family and personal demands of these selected 6 villages to be projected to the contesting candidates. Purpose of the survey was not only to identify and voice the demands of these villages but also to take a written commitment from the contesting candidates for the fulfilment of these demands once they get elected. **Perhaps obtaining the candidates written commitment on peoples' demands from the contesting candidates was done for the first time in Telangana state and may be in India.**

The survey was conducted through a printed questionnaire and in the local language ie., Telugu for easy readability. Survey was conducted in all the wards and around 90% of the



homes in each ward were covered. In around 10% of the houses, survey couldn't take place as the houses were found locked due to agriculture field activities, election rallies etc.

Analysis of the Survey

Analysis of the survey revealed many stinging facts about the practical situation existing in these villages and how these villagers have been deprived of fundamental rights and facilities due to the negligence shown by successive governments, officers and various departments since independence. The villagers are being exploited in every way and are used as a vote bank for political & party's benefits. Funds allocated to these villages under various schemes and welfare activities are either misused or underutilised.

Post-Election

- a. Met elected MLA and MP and recalled their commitment to fulfil the people's demands mentioned in Peoples Manifesto.
- b. Had meetings with the local volunteers and identified 5 critical demands to be worked in phase-I
 - i. Providing clean and fluorine-free drinking water and facilitating the Survey of land for irrigation purposes.
 - ii. Child nutrition and mother health care
 - iii. Child education
 - iv. Skill development for youth
 - v. Agriculture
- c. Conducted village and farmers meet on "Sustainable Development of Villages through Agriculture".
- d. Organised villagers' visit to solar RO and irrigation plants brought village Sarpanches and volunteers to Hyderabad and showed them the solar RO and irrigation plants as also M/s. Innofoods which is a food processing unit.
- e. Took villagers to attend the Agri Expo -2014 at Hyderabad.
- f. Conducted geological surveys to identify the groundwater in Venkipalley village.
- g. Conducted Health Camp at Vempati ZP High School with the help of NIN, Hyderabad and submitted the health and nutrition conditions of children to the then Public Distribution Minister Mr. Eetela Randar to provide school breakfast program
- h. In association with Chirra Sai Reddy Foundation donated note books to 59 govt schools in Bachannapet Mandal
- i. In association with Sri Satya Sai Annapoorna Trust provided 14000 lunches to poor people during pandemic (Pics and videos should be enclosed)
